A minimum of 50% of major (and minor) course work must be completed at University of Northwestern – St. Paul (UNW) for a Bachelor's degree. Credits you earn at CUGN with grades of "C-" or better for UNW undergraduate major and/or degrees are transferable and will be applied, as appropriate. Up to 30 of 125* credits may be taken through CUGN before transferring to UNW.
