# University of Northwestern -

## Master of Arts in Theological Studies

A maximum of 25% of University of Northwestern – St. Paul (UNW) Master of Arts in Theological Studies (MATS) degree credits may be earned by transfer credit. Credits you earn at CUGN with grades of “C” or better for UNW graduate degrees are transferable and will be applied, as appropriate. That means that up to 8 credits available at CUGN may be taken through CUGN before transferring to UNW. The following are suggested CUGN courses equivalent to courses in the UNW **Master of Arts in Theological Studies** program\*.

In order to determine your individualized academic plan at University of Northwestern, **you must contact UNW** for an evaluation\*\* of bachelor’s and post-bachelor’s degree transcripts. After you have made contact with UNW and they have received and evaluated all transcripts, they will provide you with an evaluation within 2 weeks and advise you on the CUGN courses that will apply to the UNW degree you have selected at the time of evaluation. This **individualized academic plan** will then enable you to enroll in CUGN courses and progress through your program.
