This six-week study is designed for those interested in a biblical approach to finances. Students will explore God's perspective on managing money and possessions, engaging in many practical applications for handling finances that are at the heart of a variety of financial matters.

Course Objectives

- Explain how the way you handle money has a significant impact on your relationship with Christ.
- Know the role God plays, as well as your own responsibility, in managing your finances.
- Implement scriptural principles related to work.
- Understand what Scripture says about debt and know nine steps for getting out of debt.
- Implement strategies for saving and investing.
- Understand why it is important to seek godly counsel.
- Explain what Scripture teaches about giving.
- Explain what steps you can take in a financial crisis situation.
- Explain the role eternity should play in your thinking about finances.

Begin at the top of each lesson, and work your way down through the videos, memory verses, readings, and assignments.
